- Offer services to children and families of color through our Equitable Health Fun and *It Takes a Village* program.
- Conduct intakes
- Additional opportunities to provide couples, family and group psychotherapy, psychological testing, and parent education seminars/webinars.

Requirements:

- Advanced degree in mental health and/or Provisional license LPC/LSW
- Willing to work at least 3 evenings or 2 evenings and Saturdays
- Interested in advanced training in long term psychotherapy and relationship psychotherapy skills
- Enjoys learning and ongoing supervision/consultation regardless of experience level
- Committed to providing culturally informed and affirming services
